



Year 2 Funding*

Funding proposed for a second year is provisional

- The NCESR External Advisory Committee (EAC) may authorize funds for the second year provided reporting deadlines are met and each report provides enough detail to determine whether progress is sufficient to justify continued funding, including meeting the requirement to submit a competitive grant proposal to seek supplemental funds.
- The Recipient will be notified of the EAC's decision before the end of the calendar year. Should funds be approved, the NCESR will issue an amendment to this funding award to increase the dollar amount authorized, increase the project period and detail additional reporting requirements.

* One should not assume that second year funding will automatically be issued. Year 1 funding should be spent in Year 1 and not held over to Year 2 hoping for an approval.



Closeout Process

- 30 days from end date
- Account(s) locked
- Unexpended funds returned to parent
 - Research pool
 - Designated for future research
